Message from the director ...

With so much happening around Avalon the past six months, we all are excited about what lay ahead. Requests for crisis help and support services have been on the rise and we have been adjusting within our means -- and with help from you -- to try to respond to all of those who need our services. It will all get a little easier in this new fiscal year!

Since 1980, when Avalon began providing shelter and support services for survivors of sexual and domestic violence, we have relied on our community for support. That financial support sustains essential crisis services, and your gifts multiply as they provide the required local matching funds we need to access many of our state and federal grants. The largest portion of that government support comes through The Victims of Crime Act (VOCA). The VOCA Fund was created by Congress in 1984 to provide federal support



to state and local programs that assist victims of crime. The VOCA Fund is derived entirely from fines and penalties paid by offenders at the federal level, not taxpayer revenue, and is largely distributed to the states through a formula grant. We are so pleased to report that in the new fiscal year, a much larger portion of this VOCA funding will be coming to the greater Williamsburg area and specifically to Avalon for the work we do.

The new funding will shore up current services and provide for an expansion of services. Children's Services will be improved with the addition of a full time children's counselor. We also will be adding a High Trauma Counseling specialist to specifically work with sex trafficking victims. The Outreach office now offers a support group for sexual assault. This group is open to anyone who has ever experienced a sexual assault or sexual abuse, and is offered once a week for ages 18 and above. Please contact Carolyn at 757-258-9523 for more information.

Through a partnership with Bacon Street, United Way and the Williamsburg Health Foundation, we are able to offer clients the added support of substance abuse counseling and education. As things often happen at Avalon, just as we were trying to figure out where to put these new staff members, a local contractor knocked on our front door, offering to help. The project called for renovating the interior of a building to accommodate two new counseling offices. This project included making changes to the storage buildings to accommodate donated food and clothing. A'more Enterprises, Bruton Builders and BB&T Lighthouse Project collaborated to complete this work. I think of them as angels who appeared right when we needed them!

With your generous support, coupled with strategic partnerships and increased grant funds, we are confident that Avalon will have the resources to provide comprehensive services in our community now and in the future. Working to End Elder Abuse

The Outreach office is increasing its focus on abuse to the elderly. "There were more than 21,000 reports of adult abuse, neglect and exploitation made to Virginia Adult Protective Services in the state fiscal year of 2014," says James Rothrock, of the Virginia Department of Aging. According to the National Research Council in 2003, it was estimated that between 1-2 million Americans over the age of 65 have been injured, exploited, or otherwise mistreated by someone on whom they depended for care or protection.

In a study done in 1988 by Pilleme, Karl and Finkelhor, data on elder abuse in domestic settings suggests that one in 14 incidents, excluding those of self-neglect, come to the attention of authorities. Further, as reported by John F. Wasik in *Consumers Digest* in 2000; current estimates put the overall reporting of financial exploitation at only one in 25 cases, suggesting that some five million financial abuse incidents occur each year.

These statistics are staggering, especially in a typically underserved population. At Avalon, we have recognized that it is critical we expand our services to assist the elderly to meet this need. Adult abuse may stem from caregiver abuse, financial abuse, psychological/behavior, and physical abuse. Following are signs of adult abuse, neglect or exploitation: forced isolation, lack of affection or care, perception that they are a burden, inappropriate sexual relationship, missing personal belongings, no knowledge of a monthly income, numerous unpaid bills, large bank withdrawal, suspicious signatures, unusual bank activity, depression, anxiety, anger, bruises, malnutrition, scratches, burns, soiled clothing or bedding, broken bones or sprains, restrained to bed or a chair (www.dars.virginia.gov). If you, or someone you know, has shown signs of potential elder abuse, please call us for assistance. In immediate and life threatening cases, please call 911 immediately and report it to a hospital or law enforcement.

Signs of Neglect or Self-Neglect*:

- Poor hygiene
- Inadequate supervision
- Untreated medical conditions
- No running water, electricity or heat
- Lack of needed dentures, glasses, hearing aids or medications

Signs of Adult Abuse or Exploitation*:

- Forced isolation
- Lack of affection and or care
- Inappropriate sexual relationship
- Missing belongings
- Suspicious signatures
- No money, yet receiving a monthly income
- Numerous unpaid bills
- Large bank withdrawals
- Depression

Ways to Prevent Elder Abuse

Learn the signs of abuse and neglect. Call or visit elderly loved ones and ask how they are doing. Provide a break for a caregiver. Ask your bank manager to train tellers how to detect elder financial abuse.

- Lack of communication and talking
- Anxiety
- Anger
- Dehydration or malnutrition
- Broken bones or sprains
- Scratches, burns or bruises
- Soiled clothing or bedding
- Restrained or tied to chair or a bed

Ways to give to Avalon

These days you have myriad ways to give to Avalon. Gifts of stock, automobiles, art, real estate, and planned legacy gifts.

For tax benefits, **gifts of stock** may be most beneficial for some donors. Transferring appreciated securities directly to a nonprofit can eliminate taxes on gains. Donors receive an income tax deduction for the full market value of the stock at the time of the gift. Please contact Avalon at 757-258-5022 for instructions.

IRA contributions: The Pension Protection Act allows donors age 70 ½ or older to make contributions from their Individual Retirement Account without paying income tax. The key provisions of this law are as follows: 1. You may contribute up to \$100,000 from your IRA to publicly supported charities like Avalon.
2. The transfer must be made directly to Avalon from your IRA. You may not withdraw funds and then write a check to Avalon. 3. You must be 70½ at the time of the gift. 4. You may not receive any benefits in exchange for the gift. Your IRA administrator will need this information about Avalon:
1. Legal name "Avalon: A Center for Women and Children". 2. Avalon is a qualified charitable organization under the Pension Protection Act as described in Section 170(b)(1)(A) of the Internal Revenue Code.
3. Federal Tax ID #52-1208945
4. Mailing address: Avalon, PO Box 6805, Williamsburg, Virginia 23188.

Real Estate Gifts: Gifts of property may allow donors to avoid sizable capital gains taxes.

Life Income Gifts: Establishing a "charitable remainder annuity trust" can allow for an annual return, which can be paid to you or a loved one for life, after which the assets would be distributed to Avalon.

Bequests are a wonderful way to leave a legacy; please talk to your financial advisor for guidance.
